The library accepts donations of books, DVDs, and CDs in new or gently used condition.

Donations must be brought in in a sealed box or bag. At this time, we can only accept one box or bag per person.

Donations are currently only accepted on:

Wednesdays from 9:00AM - 8:00PM
and Sundays from 1:00 - 8:00PM.

We are currently only accepting donations at the Main Library. Donations will not be accepted at our Drive-Thru Pickup Service.

Acceptable Materials:

Gently used materials in good condition are accepted.

- Books for all ages
- Music CDs
- Audiobooks on CD
- DVDs

Unacceptable Materials:

Materials in poor condition are not accepted. These include materials that exhibit stains, water-damage, odors, damaged or torn bindings or pages, yellowed or brittle pages, excessive marginal notes or highlighting.

- VHS
- Reader's Digest Books
- Newspapers
- Book Club Editions
- LPs
- Textbooks older than 3 years
- Audiobooks on Cassette & Music Cassettes
- Magazines older than 6 months
