Visit the Main Library to view “Botanical Fridas,” a series of fifteen, beautifully rendered, 8-foot tall sculptures and fifteen mini-sculptures, each of which represents a different point of view of one of the most recognized female artists, Frida Kahlo. The “Botanical Fridas” project was born from the concept of creating a cultural, artistic, and multi-national proposal that would serve as a turning point in public art installations around the world. And, like Frida Kahlo, each sculpture is accompanied by a mascot – a monkey, a xoloitzcuintle, and a deer. This exhibition debuted at the San Antonio Botanical Gardens and will tour internationally.
